Submarine Overnight on the USS Cobia – October 6-7

The Wisconsin Maritime Museum's USS COBIA Overnight Education Program offers people a once-ina-lifetime opportunity to experience first-hand a taste of the WWII submarine lifestyle and offers an appreciation of history and an insight into a unique time in America's past.

The program runs from 7:30 pm Friday night until 8:00 am Saturday morning. Our 4-H group will receive a guided tour and overnight accommodations on board the submarine. In addition to undertaking various educational activities, participants will be offered special supervised access to some non-public areas of the submarine and admission to the museum the following morning.

Participation in the overnight program is open to all 4-H members and family members. 4-H members can also invite a friend if they would like. Minimum age to participate is 6. We still have some bunks available, so we're extending the reservation deadline until all bunks are filled!
