The Program

The program will assist you in understanding and responding to the needs of your children before, during and after family transition. Guidelines on cooperative parenting and keeping children "out of the middle" will be presented. The program will provide tools to help you have a successful co-parenting relationship with your children.

Dates and Location

The program consists of one three hour session. A complete list of class dates can be found on the attached registration form. The program is conducted in Room #300 at the Manitowoc County Office Complex at 4319 Expo Drive, Manitowoc, WI 54221-0935.

Cost and Registration

The cost of the program is \$20/per parent (cash, check or money order), payable before the first session. You will not be registered for the program until the fee has been paid. You will receive an email confirmation that you are registered for the classes. If you do not have an email, you will receive a phone call to the number(s) you provided on your enrollment form. **Enrollment is limited to 25 participants per month. You will have to pick another month if enrollment is full. Be sure you plan ahead so you are able to enroll in the class that you want.**

Upon Completion

A certificate will be completed by the instructor and will fulfill the court required parent attendance needed. The instructor will file the certificate with the court.
