Preparing your own 590 Nutrient Management Plan

Nutrient management plans (NMPs) are a Statewide Conservation Performance Standard. Farmers participating in the Wisconsin Farmland Preservation (FPP) tax credit program are required to have a Nutrient Management Plan.

25 farms participating in this year's NMP Class qualify for a \$300 incentive for completing a Nutrient Management Plan. Attend these classes to learn about preparing your NMP.
