WI State Fair Dairy Promotion Scholarships

The Wisconsin State Fair Dairy Promotion Board is offering \$1,000 scholarships to be used during the second semester of the 2018-19 school year.

Third and fourth-year college students pursuing dairy-related or food science degrees at one of Wisconsin's four-year universities are eligible to apply. Additional scholarships will be available to high school seniors planning to pursue a dairy-related or food science degree at one of Wisconsin's four-year universities or students studying in a two-year, technical school program related to dairy or food science.

Applicants will be evaluated on involvement and leadership in dairy-related activities, scholastic achievement, and career objectives. Finalists will be interviewed in mid-April, with the recipients to be recognized at the 2018 Wisconsin State Fair.

This year's National 4-H Conference will be held April 6-12, 2018 at the National 4-H Center in Chevy Chase, Maryland. A team of up to 10 youth and 2 adults will plan, prepare and represent Wisconsin 4-H Youth Development Programs at the conference. The cost of National 4-H Conference is approximately \$1300. The Manitowoc County 4-H Leaders Association and 4-H Teen Ambassadors will cover half of the cost of this trip experience if a Manitowoc County youth is selected to attend National 4-H Conference as a member of the Wisconsin Delegation.

National 4-H Conference delegates engage in personal development experiences that increase their knowledge, resources, and skills while they discuss topics affecting youth and 4-H programming nationwide. Delegates not only learn while at the conference: they are empowered to create positive

social change in their communities and have the opportunity to practice and apply their skills in a realworld setting.


