- Ask a business if you can paint their windows with a 4-H theme.
- If a business has a marquee, ask if they will use it to promote 4-H for a week.

County S.T.A.R. Award

S.T.A.R. stands for Secretary, Treasurer and Reporter. The S.T.A.R. Award application, along with the appropriate book(s), are due at the UWEX/4-H Youth Development Office by Friday, September 28th. It is at the discretion of the Main Leader as to the date he/she sets for STAR Award books to be turned into them. The Secretary's, Treasurer's and Reporter's books are evaluated separately. (This means your club does not have to turn in all three books to apply for this award.) Books can be turned in individually or as a club. There are no interviews for this award. It is based upon completion of the book.

Do not include pictures, clippings and certificates in the secretary's book but do include them in the reporter's book (scrapbook).

- Briefly explain how the club members were involved in the planning and implementation of the project.
