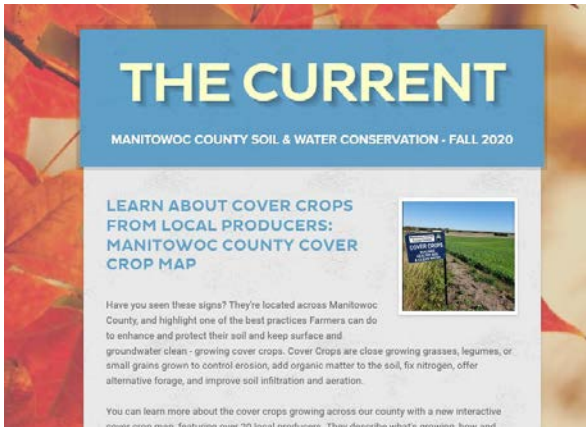

Apply for Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) funding by November 20, 2020.



From weather to pests, each American farmer faces a unique set of challenges. The Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) provides financial and technical assistance to agricultural and forestry producers to address natural resource concerns and deliver environmental benefits such as improved water and air quality, conserved ground and surface water, reduced soil erosion and sedimentation, and improved or created wildlife habitat.

Through EQIP, NRCS provides agricultural producers with financial resources and one-on-one help to plan and

implement improvements, or what NRCS calls conservation practices. This voluntary conservation programs helps producers make conservation work for them. If you have a resource concern or would like more information, contact your local NRCS agency at 920-683-5119. Applications for 2021 EQIP Funding are due by November 20, 2020.
