Important Updates and Changes to Junior Eligibility at Wisconsin State Fair

Wisconsin State Fair is changing their eligibility requirements for Junior Division competitions, contests, exhibits, demonstrations and special activity opportunities that are provided by Wisconsin State Fair. The message states:

“Youth are encouraged to actively participate in youth educational programs/organizations which enhance project awareness but there are **NO YOUTH ORGANIZATION MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS** to exhibit in Youth Expo or the Junior animal Departments of Wisconsin State Fair. Rules for acceptance; Wisconsin State Fair Park does not and shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion (creed), gender, gender expression, age, national origin (ancestry), physical ability, marital status, sexual orientation, or military status, in any of its activities or *operations*.”
