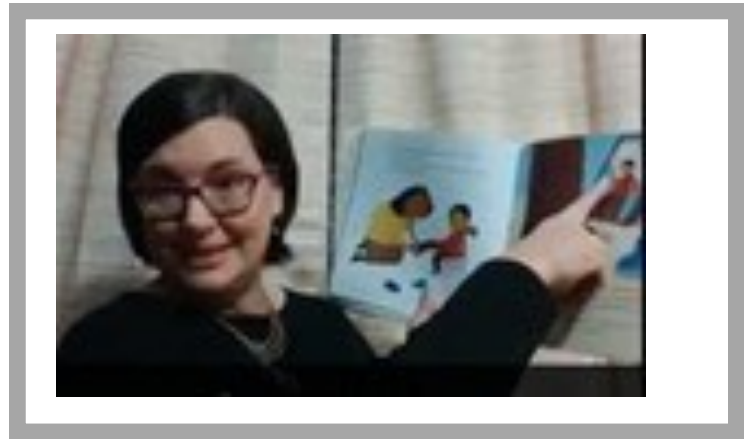
Money as You Grow Training

Designed for child care providers, librarians, after school staff, and others who work with children, Money as You Grow uses children's books to teach kids about money. Children as young as 3 can learn basic financial concepts that help prepare them to make sound money decisions as adults.



Here's what you'll get in this one-hour training:

- Information on the 29 books in the Money as You Grow series
- Access to the parent guides for each book. Parent guides feature suggested family discussion questions and activities related to the messages in the books
- Access to book read videos: UW-Madison Extension educators reading all of the books in the series and offering conversation and activity tips
- Background on the learning areas and key ideas that serve as the foundation for the money and executive function skills that children learn through the program
