# 2024 MANITOWOC COUNTY UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN AGRICULTURE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE

The Manitowoc County UW-Agriculture Alumni Association Board is pleased to announce that up to \$1,000 scholarships will be available for students from Manitowoc County enrolling in their first and/or second year\* in agriculture or life sciences degree programs at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, Platteville, River Falls, Green Bay or Stevens Point, or in the Residential Farm & Industry Short Course at UW-River Falls. Examples of eligible majors include but are not limited to traditional production agriculture majors like dairy science, soil science and agronomy. Other majors may qualify including: biochemistry, genetics, molecular biology, forestry, horticulture, environmental science and more.

\*The UW-Ag Alumni Association scholarship is also available to students transferring from a non-agriculture program to their first and/or second year in an agriculture or life sciences degree program at one of the aforementioned colleges.

\*Preference will be given to first year applicants that meet the qualifications, however, if adequate scholarship dollars are available, qualified second year students, including prior recipients who are qualified second year students, may be eligible for a Manitowoc County University of Wisconsin Agriculture Alumni Association Scholarship.

Scholarship amounts will depend on the number of qualified applicants. These scholarships are made available through the cooperation and support of numerous businesses, organizations and individuals in Manitowoc County. The Board of Directors of the Manitowoc County UW-Agriculture Alumni Association will make the selections. All decisions are final.

Each applicant must return the attached application form to the Manitowoc County UW-Extension Office, c/o the "Manitowoc County UW-Agriculture Alumni Association", P.O. Box 935, Manitowoc, WI 54221-0935, by March 15, 2024. The Selection Committee must also be provided with three letters of recommendation by that date. Instructions for those writing letters of recommendation are included on an attached sheet. Selection will be based on the application and the letters of recommendation. Winners will receive 3 complimentary tickets to the UW-Ag Alumni Banquet on Tuesday April 16th, 2024 and should plan to attend.

The purpose of the scholarship is to encourage deserving young men and women to pursue further education to better equip them for the operation of a farm or to assume employment and leadership responsibilities in another phase of agriculture. Payment of the scholarship will be made to the institution after they have enrolled and started classes in the fall.
