The Market Animal Committee (MAC) established a scholarship fund for market animal exhibitors of beef, swine, sheep and goats. High school students that have or will be graduating in 2024 who plan to enroll in a post-secondary education. First year college students can also apply. To be eligible for this scholarship, the applicant must have participated in the Manitowoc County Market Animal Show and Sale in one or more previous years. The application and list of guidelines are enclosed. If eligible for this scholarship, please fill out and submit the enclosed information by **Monday, April 1, 2024.**

(A minimum of \$10,000.00 will be available for scholarship allocation this year.)

The scholarship recipient(s) will be notified by the MAC in April and will be recognized at the Market Animal Sale on Thursday, August 22, 2024. To receive funds, transcripts must be provided at the end of the first semester. Please contact Jean Grotegut at 920-323-0410 with any questions.

Qualifications:

- 1) Applicants must be an upcoming 2024 high school graduate or a first-year college student.
- 2) Applicants must have participated in the Manitowoc County Market Animal Show and Sale in one or more previous years.

To apply:

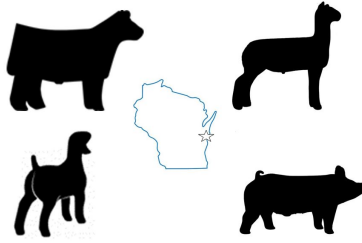
- 1) Complete and submit "Personal Information Form" (see attached).
