


Bamboo tree - We will use bamboo skewers and rope to create a holiday bamboo tree. A great décor for the holidays.

Popcorn Balls - Let's pop some popcorn and make holiday popcorn balls.






Ice Cream Making - Let's make ice cream in a bag and enjoy eating homemade ice cream.
